Who can use DuRide?

If you are 65 or older and live in Dubuque, East Dubuque, or Asbury, you can use DuRide.

How do I use DuRide?

Call DuRide to arrange for a ride whenever you need it, for whatever you need. You will ride with a licensed, insured volunteer in their personal vehicle.

Use DuRide to go anywhere you need to go in Dubuque, Asbury, or East Dubuque.

- Medical appointments
- Errands
- Hairdresser
- Shopping and dining out
- Church services
- Visiting friends and relatives
- Recreational activities: movies, concerts, plays, exercise



If you need help with steps, heavy doors, walkers, or packages, your DuRide volunteer can assist you.

How Do I Sign Up?

Call DuRide at (563) 451-4999 to find out more. We will mail you the information and an application to fill out and mail back.

The process is simple:

- You pay a small annual fee and a small pick-up fee. No money changes hands with the driver.
- You receive a monthly statement and pay it like any other bill.
- Grants, donations, local sponsors, and support from the City of Dubuque make rides affordable.
- Discounted rides are offered through our income assistance program.



Why is becoming a DuRide volunteer so important?

Without transportation, many seniors withdraw from their communities, family, and friends.

DuRide is a unique, non-profit system that provides safe, dignified, and flexible transportation. DuRide keeps seniors healthier, more active, and engaged with their communities.



Volunteer on your terms.

Volunteer only when you have time. There are no minimum commitments or assigned rides. The typical volunteer provides six to ten rides a month — some more, some less — as your schedule allows.

Volunteering is simple.

You will receive daily emails showing the requested rides. If you see something that fits your schedule, let us know.

- You need a current driver's license, proof of insurance, and must pass a background check.
- You use your own vehicle.
- You'll receive a yearly statement that shows your rides and number of miles you drove.
